

Andhra Pradesh to get a new 50MW solar power plant

May 21, 2015: A place near Kadiri in the Anantpur district of Andhra Pradesh will soon get a 50MW solar power plant. The project is being undertaken by National Thermal Power Corporation Limited (NTPC Ltd), who has further given the responsibility of setting up the plant to Sterling and Wilson. Having ample amount of experience behind them, Sterling and Wilson's scope of work in this project

would vary across departments including design, engineering, supply, installation and commissioning of the grid connecting 50MW solar PV project on a turnkey basis.
